BIRDING PRESQUE ISLE



Presque Isle State Park is one of the Top 10 Birding Sites in the nation. Experience Fall Waterfowl migration on the shores of Presque Isle or visit during exciting Spring Warbler migration. Stop at various sites along the park to learn bird identification under the guidance of our park naturalist and discover why Presque Isle is an ideal spot for bird viewing. Get outdoors and view the birds up close using binoculars and a spotting scope and learn the basics of field identification using field guides.
